#### Guidelines for Miniature Gardens

**Containers:** Any size, old or new, painted or unpainted wheelbarrows; terrariums, wagons, wash tubs, tea cups or other containers are acceptable. These containers should not have holes or cracks where water and soil can leak out. **These containers must not leak!**

**Plants:** Use living plants, such as dwarf or small plants. The hosts of the exhibit will mist the plants in need of water, but plants should also be watered when the garden is set up. Add rocks or Styrofoam packing material in the bottom of the garden to prevent soggy soil.

**Clean Up:** Please bring your miniature garden put together as much as possible. Please clean up any mess you make. A broom and dustpan will be available in the front hall.

**Theme:** This year the theme of the Hydrangea Festival is "Magical Triumph". However, you do not have to stick to this theme. Just use your imagination and have FUN!
